



## HSV Protocol regarding COVID-19 (August 2022)

### Basic Rules

HSV adheres to the basic rules as set by the national government:



- Wash your hands often.
- Sneeze and cough into your elbow.
- If you have Covid-19 complaints, stay at home and do a test.
- Ensure a good flow of fresh air.
- Get your initial vaccinations and booster jab.

### Additional Measures

For both students and staff, the following additional provisions apply within HSV.

In case of (cold) complaints stay at home and do a self-test. If the result of the self-test is **negative**, you can come back to school. If the result of the test is **positive** then the student / staff member goes into isolation. For a minimum of five days and a maximum of ten days. Are you free of symptoms for 24 hours after that? Then you can come back to school.

If a student or staff member has been in close contact with a person who has been diagnosed with a corona infection, the above advice also applies.

If a student is tested positive for Covid-19 the parents of the other students in this class will be informed.

Ventilation: Every classroom has a CO2-meter, so you can see if it is necessary to open the windows in between classes.

With this, the obligations concerning the wearing of mouth masks, keeping a distance of 1.5 meters, testing at the GGD and the provisions for pregnant employees have been dropped.
